As we enter the long hot summer, we as Floridians start to think about taking some time off to enjoy our outdoors, participate in recreational activities and enjoy a cook out with our families and friends. Now the opportunities to enjoy all of these pursuits within Wilton Manors have never been better. In 1998 the citizens and voters of Wilton Manors overwhelmingly approved a bond issue to improve our existing parks, expand the existing municipal library and to acquire additional park property. The result of the City's plans is now available for the full enjoyment of all of the residents and visitors to the Island City. The brand new waterfront Island City Park Preserve located at 823 NE 28th Street off NE 6th Avenue provides picnic shelters, multi-purpose courts, boardwalk river overlooks, tot lots and many other relaxing open spaces. A completely new 6,000 square foot community center has been built at Hagen Park, located behind City Hall. Amenities include a roller rink/basketball court; 6 newly resurfaced tennis courts, new playground facilities, and picnic shelter. At Colohatchee Park the mangrove nature area boardwalk has been completely rebuilt and new restrooms for the boat ramp on the east side of NE 15th Avenue has been provided. Kayak rentals are available from the Island City Park beach and the Colohatchee boat ramp areas. The Library expansion is truly a well done project and an outstanding children's area is especially provided. So there's a lot to do right here in the City, so enjoy the summer and explore all that's available right here and save on gas!!!
