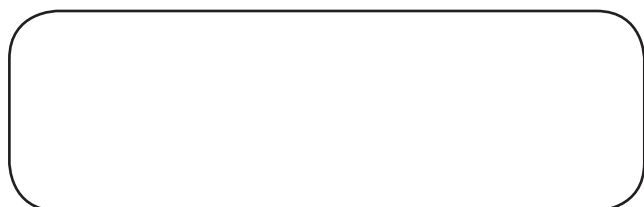

Greetings from the Mayor

The 2006 Hurricane Season begins Tuesday, June 1st and although our community was affected last year by Katrina, Rita and Wilma, experts still tell us that the majority of us are even now not prepared for this year's possible storms. Eight months later there is still evidence of Wilma's destruction by the blue tarps visible throughout the City on homes, businesses and churches! I am therefore recommending that we all prepare early and, better yet, begin preparing NOW! Each of us is responsible for having an appropriate amount of supplies (food, gas, water, etc.) available for every member of the family to be self sufficient for at least three days.

Last year several areas of the City were without electricity for two weeks and in some areas, were without potable water for three or more days. It is impossible to estimate from storm to storm how long we will be without utilities, but we still need to be prepared as best we can. City employees can only do so much to provide emergency supplies to all who are in need in the aftermath.

And if you or someone you know is disabled, elderly, or has special needs, please call the City of Wilton Manors Human Resources Dept. at 954-390-2125 to be placed on a list (name, address and contact phone number) so that we can keep in touch before, during and after a hurricane to provide special assistance.
