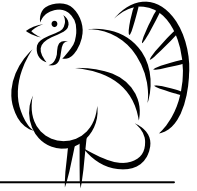

## Member Spotlight- Dr. Janis Turner, Chiropractic Physician

holiday discounts to festival goers.

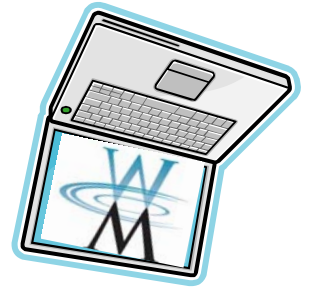
### **Sunday, December 7, Christmas Tree Auction**
